Why You Need an Art Page

- Keeps art separate from personal life A professional space for your work without mixing in personal updates.
- Looks more professional Galleries and buyers take you more seriously.
- Easier for people to find you Facebook Pages show up in Google searches.
- Provides useful tools Insights, scheduling posts, and running promotions.

Step-by-Step Guide

On a Computer (Best for full customization)

- Log in to Facebook and go to the Menu (grid icon) > Click "Pages"
- 2. Click "Create New Page"
- 3. Enter Page Info:
 - Page Name (Your artist name, e.g., "Jane Doe Art")
 - o Category (Select "Artist" or "Visual Artist"),
 - Description (Brief bio, e.g., "I oreate expressive watercolor landscapes.")
- 4. Click "Create Page"
- 5. Add Profile & Cover Photos
 - o Profile Photo Your artwork or logo.
 - Cover Photo A banner featuring your best work.
- 6. Customize Your Page
 - Edit details: Website, contact info, social links.
- Create a Username (Optional) Example: @JaneDoeArt
- 8. Make Your First Post!
 - Share an artwork photo with a short introduction.
- 9. Invite Friends & Followers
 - Click "Invite Friends" to spread the word.
- 10. Adjust Settings (Optional) Notifications, messaging, and visibility.

On an iPhone (Facebook App)

- Open Facebook App > Tap Menu (three lines at bottom right) > Tap "Pages"
- 2. Tap "Create"

- 3. Enter Page Name, Category, and Description
- 4. Tap "Create Page"
- 5. Add **Profile & Cover Photos** (Choose from camera roll)
- 6. Tap "Edit Page Info" to update details.
- 7. Make a First Post
- 8. Invite People to Like Your Page
- 9. Adjust Notifications & Settings (if needed)

On an Android Phone (Facebook App)

- 1. Open Facebook App > Tap Menu (three lines at top right) > Tap "Pages"
- 2. Tap "Create" and enter Page Info (same steps as iPhone)
- 3. Add Profile & Cover Photos
- 4. Customize Page Info & Settings
- 5. Post your First Artwork
- 6. Invite Friends & Adjust Notifications
