



Check out the art exhibit of the Chippewa Valley Watercolor Association's spring art show located in the lower level. Many VAA members represented at the show. It is there through July 24th.





ARRIVALS & CALL FOR ART

Heyde Center for the Arts, Chippewa Falls, WI September 5 - October 16, 2024 Reception and Awards Ceremony: Sunday, September 8, 2-4 pm

A juried show of 2D and 3D works inspired by or interpretations of the theme, *Arrivals* and *Departures*. The theme can be interpreted broadly or specifically based on concepts and ideas related to arrivals and/or departures.

Open to all artists 18 years and older residing in the states of Wisconsin, Minnesota, lowa, Illinois, and Michigan. \$40 jury fee allows up to three entries. Entry deadline is August 5 at midnight.

Best of Show: \$800

1st Place: \$500 2nd Place: \$300 3rd Place: \$150

- Digital entries will be juried by a panel of art professionals
- All awards based on judging of actual artworks at the Heyde Center for the Arts
